

The first letter in the right column reads AND O, BUT ONE, OR TWO, indicating three values for a Ternary code. Reading triples down the middle with this encoding results in 021 001 202 012 201 which decodes in Ternary to the answer: GATES


FOUR-LEGGED ZOO




