The Inspector interviewed each suspect about the murder, and their replies are below. Rearrange them according to the following rules.

- The layout is a 4x4 checkerboard of alternating nobles and servants, except for the bottom row on the right, where the cooks are.
- Cora, Mary, and Robert each have their servant next to them.
- Three common flower names are in a diagonal, along with another woman.
- Violet is not next to Anna.
- Cora is backed against a wall by her daughters, who are next to her.
- Carson and Mrs. Hughes are at the center of everything, ensuring that the crafty Baxter and Thomas are as far apart as possible.
- Molesley is the only male on the left half, and is next to two males.

"Next to" refers to any of the eight neighboring locations. Once everyone was rearranged, the Inspector took a step back to survey the suspects. He didn't need to draw on his years of experience because the first thing he saw gave him everything he needed to crack the case. He bagged the murder weapon as evidence, and wrote its name on the answer sheet.
