## **BONUS: JACK FLASH DOES VEGAS**

Solution: what the four "hands" have in common is that they have their *suit symbols all lined up precisely*, all suits different, and they add up to "21" using standard "21" or "black jack" rules. There are 17 more such straight hands – many of them sharing corner cards – as shown in the example set, for a total of twenty-one 21's, and when the lines are all drawn in to connect these hands, the following figure is revealed. It may take a little time to discern a human form jumping over what appears to be a street. Putting together the number 21 – jump and street will hopefully lead to the solution as to what late 80's era television show they were watching "21 Jump Street."
