Flowers blooming, days lengthening, warmth returning... and unbridled optimism always welling forth...

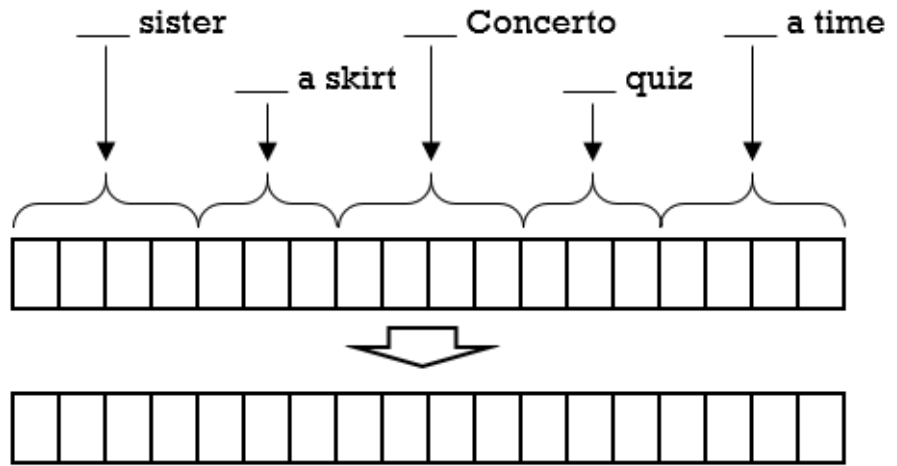

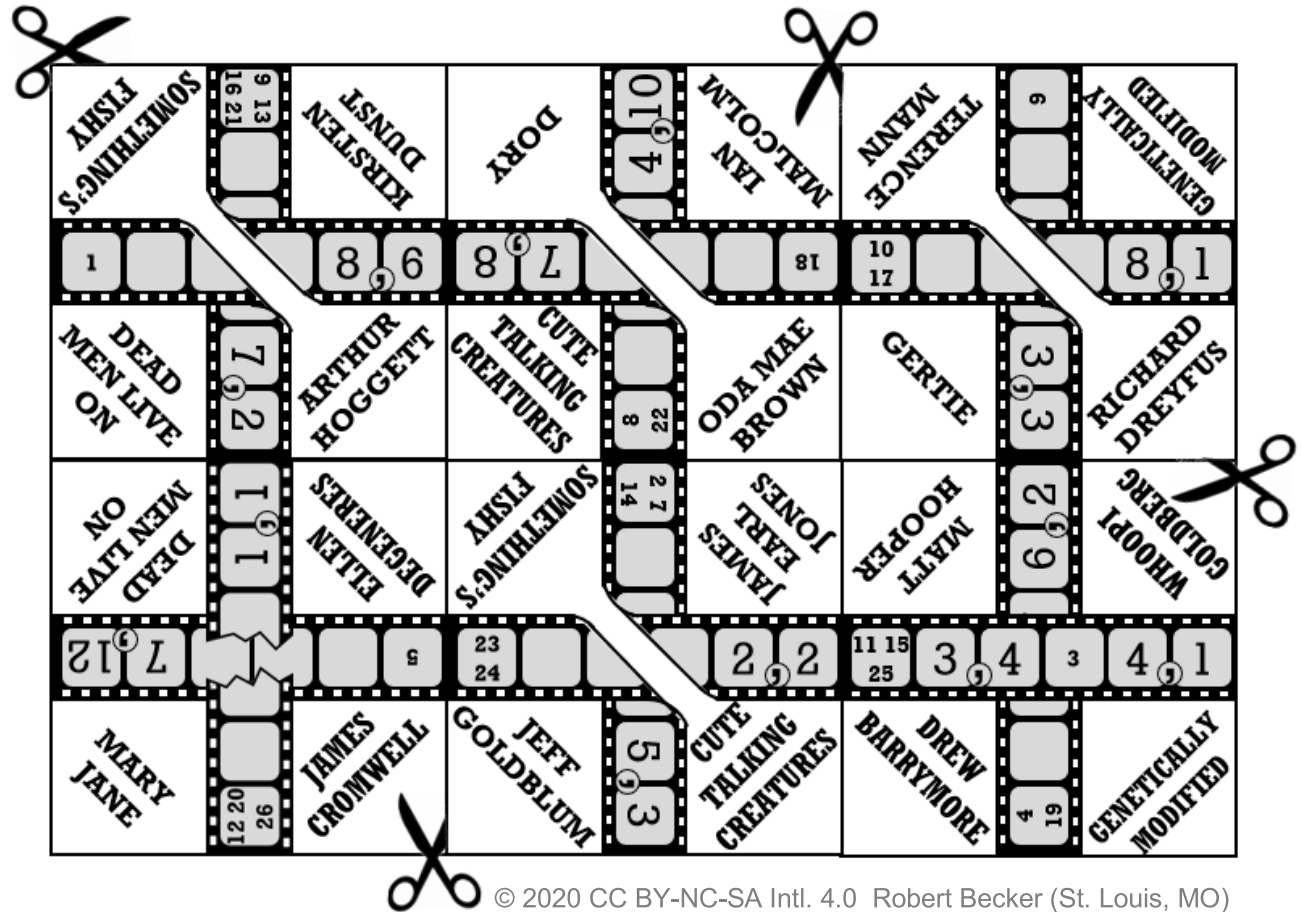
CHILLIN' IN THE MULTIPLEX (1/2)

then go have some fun!

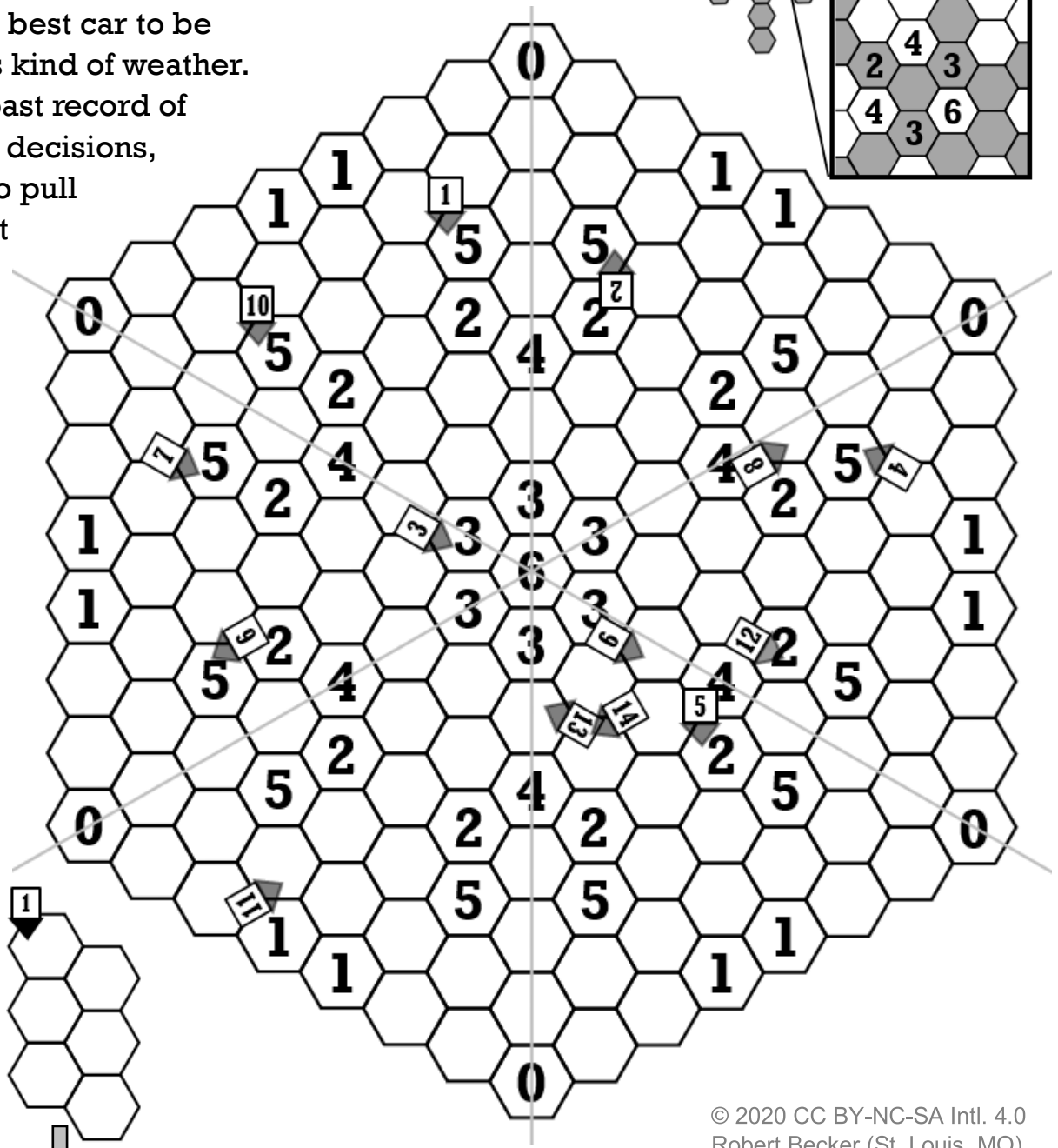
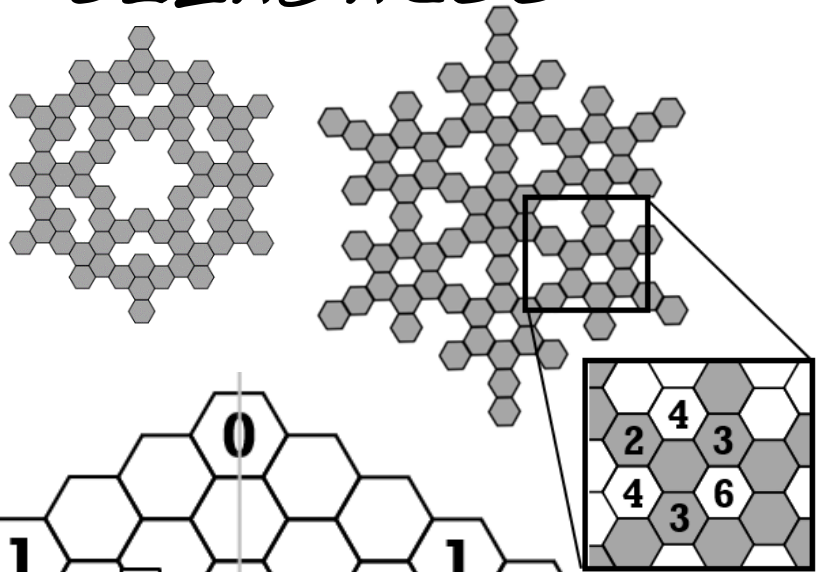
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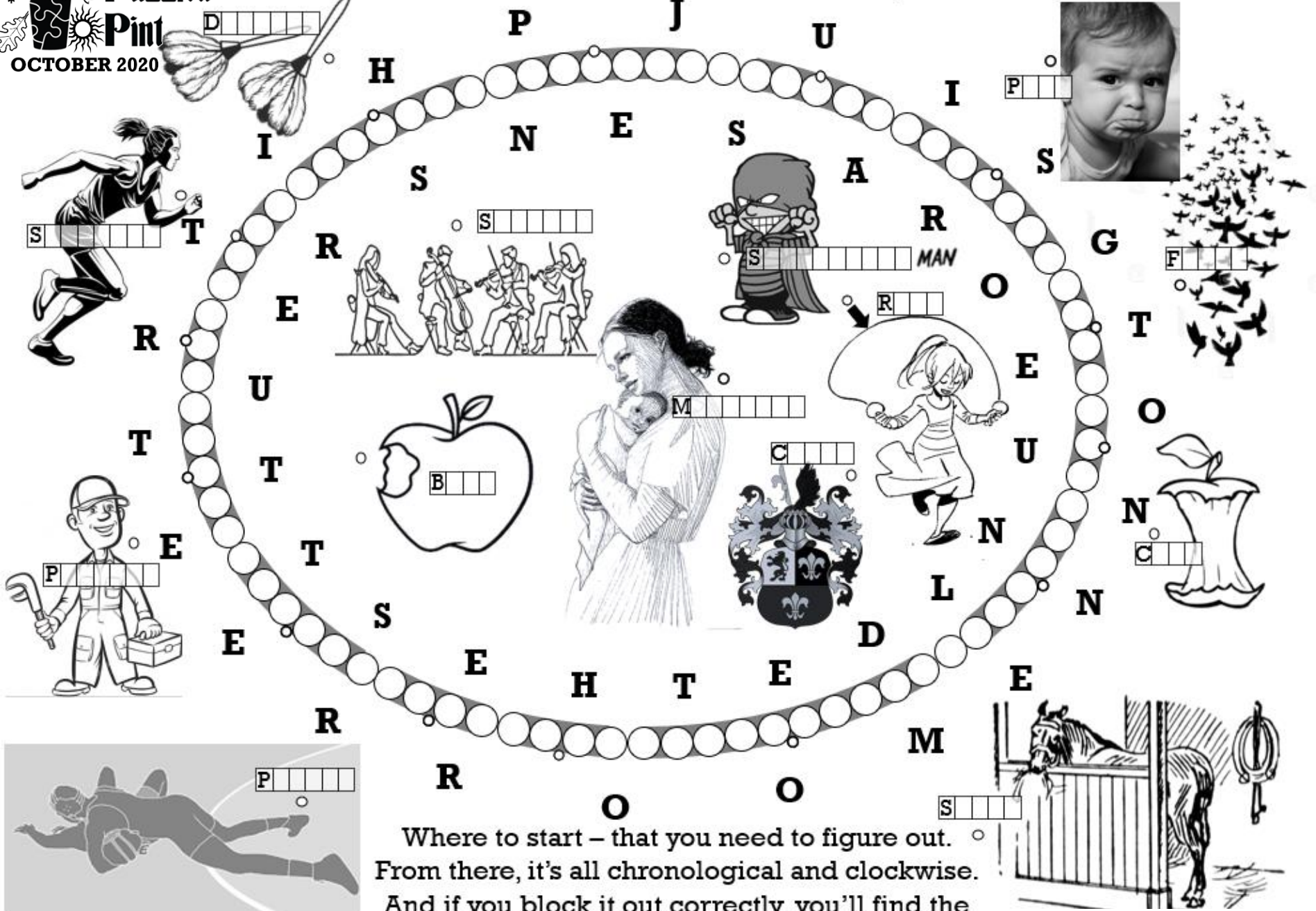
SNOW BLINDNESS
