

Kiki's Delivery Supply Chain




Kiki is a busy witch today! She needs to make 7 deliveries before she can hang out with her friends. After planning out her flight path, Kiki realizes she has forgotten where they all agreed to meet! Hopefully something along her route will **signal** the location.




Kiki starts her day at Osono's Bakery (K). Below is her list of deliveries. Help her find where to meet her friends!

- Order 1: Pick up a herring pie from Madame at (C) and deliver it to her granddaughter at (F).
- Order 2: Pick up a loaf of fresh bread at the bakery (K) and deliver it to Tombo at (N).
- Order 3: Pick up a toy cat from Maki at (O) and deliver it to Ket at (P). [Note: don't drop it!]
- Order 4: Pick up a ham roll from the bakery (K) and deliver it to the clocktower caretaker (J).
- Order 5: Pick up some art supplies from the general store (G) and deliver them to Ursula (E).
- Order 6: Pick up a push-broom from the general store (G) and deliver it to the street sweeper (B).
- Order 7: Pick up a painting from Ursula (E) and deliver it to the policeman (H).





Sōsuke and his mom race home as their coastal town quickly floods. When they reach their house, Sōsuke **looks back** and marvels at their perilous path. Where are his friends waiting out the storm?

Connect the islands using bridges and the following rules:

- Bridges must begin and end at distinct islands, travelling in a straight line.
- Bridges must not cross any other bridges or islands.
- Bridges may only run horizontally or vertically.
- At most two bridges can connect a pair of islands.
- The number of bridges connected to each island must match the number on that island.
- The bridges must join the islands into a single connected group.

After completing the bridges, move the car (upper left corner) to the house (lower right corner). It can only travel between islands if there are two bridges.





Howl's Moving Mess (1/2)




Howl's castle was a disaster. Sophie **couldn't see** beyond the clutter. She spent all day cleaning but didn't get to every room.

What was the last thing she cleaned?


- Rooms are composed of squares (see next page).

- One of the bathrooms is clean and the other is dirty.
- The study was the first room she cleaned.
