3. Use the phrases below to connect the center place (the queen with two other plates). This will create semaphore.

2 & 9

= Q

Some of the Queen's birthday celebrations will take place at Buckingham Palace.

2 & 11

= U

Prince William and Kate will be at the Buckingham Palace with the Queen.

2 & 6

= E

When the Queen is living at Buckingham Palace, you will see her corgis everywhere.

2 & 6

= E

The Queen's corgis are fed fresh rabbit and beef when at Buckingham Palace.

5 & 8

= N

The Queen's Silver and Diamond Jubilees occurred 35 years apart.

3 & 8

= M

It is a shame that Prince George was not yet born, as he missed the Queen's Diamond Jubilee.

9 & 11

= O

The Queen is expected to have birthday cake with Prince William and Princess Kate.

11 & 12

= T

Prince William played in a charity polo event that the Queen attended.

8 & 9

= H

It looks like the Queen's 90th Birthday will be a smaller celebration than her Diamond Jubilee.

2 & 6

= E

The Queen's corgis reside in the Corgi Room at Buckingham Palace.

3 & 9

= R

The adorable Prince George will be also attending the Queen's birthday parade.
