




Transit Planning

Connect Portland's neighborhoods with high-quality transit!
 Each neighborhood (represented by a circle) must be serviced by the given number of bus routes.

- Up to two routes may directly connect each pair of neighborhoods.
- Good transit is important, so all the neighborhoods must be connected in one network.
- Portland is laid out as a grid – routes are only vertical or horizontal.
- Finally, routes cannot cross.
