



The Rocinante is in an asteroid field in the belt and needs to navigate through. Alex knows the number and sizes of the asteroids in the field, but the Rocinante could only fully locate one. Help him figure out where the rest of the asteroids are so that he can navigate the ship through the field, careful to **not even brush up adjacent to any asteroids** lest he damage the Roci. Since each **turn** burns extra fuel, he also wants to make as few turns as possible along his route.

Note that any two asteroids cannot touch, even diagonally, and the numbers on the outside of the grid represent the total numbers of asteroid tiles in each row/column. Oblong asteroids can be placed horizontally or vertically.


