WHICH LETTERS ARE JUST NEVER CROSSED BY ANY MESSAGES?

The grid consists of 14 columns and 10 rows. The letters and arrows are as follows:

- Row 1: C, A, N, T, A, L, K, W, A, T, C, H, I, T
- Row 2: S, T, Z, C, A, S, G, S, E, N, Y, Z, A
- Row 3: U, E, A, E, N, N, Y
- Row 4: J, O, R, O, S, S, R, E, E, D, B
- Row 5: E, V, T, A, V, U
- Row 6: R, R, L, T, T, T, T
- Row 7: A, Z, M, D, H, A, R, R, O, W, S, T, U
- Row 8: R, I, C, A, L, I, G
- Row 9: S, D, N, K, H, W, A, T, C, H, I, T
- Row 10: (Empty)

Arrows indicate paths between letters. A 'START' arrow points to the bottom of the 7th column.
