During her vacation, Alex picked up a map of local points of interest. She decided to take a walk from one end of town to the other, visiting places along the way. She wanted to see 8 landmarks and her route caused her to intersect with numerous beautiful Portland neighborhoods. If you trace her steps, you will know what she achieved at the end of her journey.

Her first stop was the Davis Theater. It was closed that morning so she cut over to the river to see the wreck of the Lexington. From there she went to see the nautical exhibits at the Flanders Museum. She took the ferry across the river and cut through the Quimby Campground to sit down and eat lunch at the Salmon Picnic Grounds. Along the way she scraped her arm, so she checked in at the first aid station. The attendant provided a small band-aid and she was good to head to the Eliot Theater. When finished there, she headed to the endpoint of her walk.

- 1. Draw a line, plotting the path from the beginning star through the eight points that were visited, to the finish star.
- 2. Look at the letters that path intersects. There's one letter pulled from each word-crossing, so only use the most central letter at the more slanted intersections. You will get: INDEX SYMBOL
- 3. Now take the same path and use the name of the map symbol for each location. Index by the map grid number along the top/bottom:

TH(E)ATER, 3
E(X)POSED WRECK, 2
MUS(E)UM, 4
FER(R)Y, 4
(C)AMPGROUND, 1
P(I)CNIC GROUNDS, 2
FIR(S)T AID, 4
TH(E)ATER, 3
